2009 Nominating Committee Activities

- Initial Meeting: 7-8 November 2008 in Cairo
- 11 Teleconference calls: December 2008 June 2009
- November to April: Outreach focus, more open "promotion" approach (including eg lanyards, booth, etc) and active outreach work, including at ICANN Mexico Meeting and dedicated event in London, UK
- Nomination period for SOIs: 2 December, 2008 15 April, 2009
- Analysis work done, April to June, supported by international search firm, OdgersBerntdson (4 Meetings with OB during period)
- Committee members review of candidates based on Statements of Interest, references, OB assessments and "Deep Diver"analysis
- June 27-29: "Face-to-face" selection meeting Sydney, Australia
- July/August: Due Diligence
- Announcement: 28 August 2009
- Successful Candidates seated: Seoul 2009 Annual Meeting
